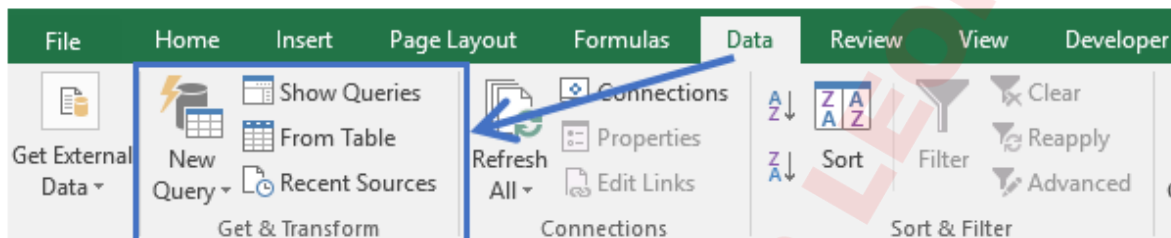


Excel Power Query Availability

For Microsoft Excel 2016 & above including Office 365

Power Query is included with Excel 2016 and above (inclusive of Office 365). It has been renamed and is now on the Data tab of the Ribbon in the Get & Transform group. So, there is nothing to install.

Power Query is Included with Excel 2016 for Windows

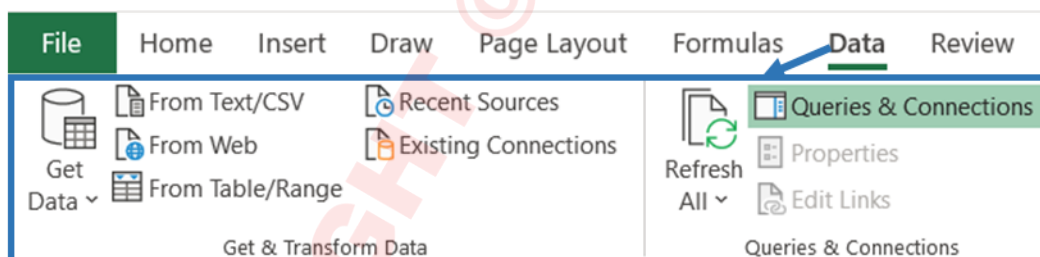


Power Query is now included on the Get & Transform section of the Data tab. There is NOTHING TO INSTALL.

Note: If your Excel version is Excel 2016 and not the same as the picture shown above, you must perform an Excel update. If necessary, ask your IT department to update your Excel.

For versions that are beyond Excel 2016, Power Query is already included from the “**Get & Transform Data**” group in the “**Data**” tab of the Ribbon (see picture below).
